

On 10-18-07 I was instructed to go to 649 North 2nd Avenue in Phoenix, Arizona and make contact with Michele Iafrate of Iafrate & Associates. Upon arrival I made contact with Mrs. Iafrate, who told me that a reporter named Ray Stern from the "New Times" had come to her office about 0910 hours that morning to view some paperwork that the New Times had requested using The Freedom of Information Act. Mrs. Iafrate explained to me that when Stern was talking with her law clerk, Cari Shehorn, he began to raise his voice which caused her (Iafrate) to stop what she was doing and leave her office so that she could check on Mrs. Shehorn's welfare. Mrs. Iafrate told me that several other employees overheard the commotion and became concerned. Mrs. Iafrate gave me a copy of a memorandum which was authored by her law clerk, Cari Shehorn. Mrs. Iafrate told me that Mrs. Shehorn was rattled by the whole incident with Stern.

In the memorandum, Mrs. Shehorn described what had occurred at the law office involving Ray Stern. I interview Mrs. Shehorn, and was given an account of what had transpired which coincided with the information provided in the memorandum that she had written (See attached memorandum). Mrs. Shehorn told me verbally, that Stern began to photograph several items that he was only supposed to view. Mrs. Shehorn told me that Stern was taking photos with a small camera which she had not noticed Stern carrying when he came into the business. Mrs. Shehorn told me that she advised Stern that he had two options; he could view the documents or have copies of the documents made which he could then take with him. Mrs. Shehorn told me that Stern refused to stop taking photos and became argumentative, raising his voice at her. Mrs. Shehorn also told me that several other employees overheard the commotion.

I spoke with Beverly, another employee in the building. Beverly told me that she was in the basement and overheard the commotion caused by Stern. Beverly told me that she didn't know if she should stay in the basement or come up stairs to see what was going on. Beverly told me that she contemplated calling 911 because she wasn't sure what was going on.

I also spoke with Courtney, another employee in the building. Courtney told me that she could hear the yelling and went into the conference room to make sure that everything was alright. Courtney told me that Stern kept repeating himself saying, "Why are you kicking me

out?". Courtney told me that Stern also made the statement, "Good luck with your.....". Mrs. Iafrate told me that as Stern was leaving he made the statement, "Good luck with your practice!"

I also spoke with Rebecca, another employee in the building. Rebecca told me that she was the person who showed Stern into the room when he arrived. Rebecca told me that she had heard Stern yelling and went into the conference room to check on Cari to make sure that she was alright.

The information provided by the previously mentioned witnesses shows that Ray Stern disturbed several employees in a normally quite business by unnecessarily raising his voice to a level which caused concern for the safety of another employee. It is believed that Ray Stern committed Disorderly Conduct a violation of Arizona Revised Statutes 13-2904.a.2.

At approximately 1930 hours Detective Anthony #1147 and I went to Raymond Stern's home located at 1430 South Grand View Drive in Tempe, Arizona and issued him citation number 0272077 charging him with Disorderly Conduct. Raymond Stern signed the citation promising to appear for court.

Meeting with Ray Stern

Jill Laformara scheduled an appointment for *New Times*' reporter, Ray Stern to come to our office and review documents that MCSO had gathered pursuant to Stern's public records request. Mr. Stern arrived at lafrate & Associates at approximately 9:10 a.m. Rebecca Franco showed Mr. Stern to the conference room. I introduced myself to Mr. Stern. He asked if I was an attorney at the firm and I responded that I am not and that I am a law clerk. I noted that Mr. Stern had a drink with him and asked if he'd like a glass of water or anything else. He said, "No, thank you." We chatted for a minute or two about the coffee house from which he purchased his drink and then I handed him the stack of gathered documents. I proceeded to set up my laptop to complete some work while Mr. Stern reviewed the documents. After a few minutes, I heard Mr. Stern's camera and looked up and saw that he was photographing the document in front of him. I wrote a note on the legal pad I had and excused myself to go into the kitchen. I gave the note to Courtney Cloman and asked Courtney to take the note into Michele lafrate. On the note I asked Michele if he (Stern) could photograph pages? Courtney brought the note back into me in the conference room. Michele's response stated that Stern could either pay for copies or inspect the documents—that is what the public records request allows. Michele instructed me to tell Stern again that I am not an attorney and that if he insists on something other than this, he needed to make an appointment with Michele.

After reading the note, I said, "Mr. Stern, it's my understanding that you're here reviewing records pursuant to a public records request. Is that correct? He said "yes." I said "I don't believe the public records statute allows for your photographing of documents." Mr. Stern said that that he was within his legal right and that the

statute doesn't say he can't photograph documents. I asked Mr. Stern to stop photographing documents. He asked what my legal justification was. I again told him that I could not give him one as I am not an attorney. I told him that he would have to schedule a meeting with Michele to discuss this and work it out with her later. Mr. Stern told me that he was going to continue taking photographs. I then told Mr. Stern I had to ask him to leave. Mr. Stern did not leave and continued photographing. I told Mr. Stern I was politely asking him to stop and if he was not going to he would have to leave the premises. Stern stayed where he was. I told him that if he did not leave at my request, he was trespassing. Mr. Stern said what I was doing here was un-American and that he had every right to review the documents. I said that "yes, he did have a right to review the documents, but not to photograph them." I also stated that when another *New Times* reporter, Steve Lemmons had come to review documents, he marked the documents he wanted copies of, we copied them and provided them to him and all went smoothly. Stern said that he also wanted copies (yet he had no post-its or flags with him to mark any documents), but that he had the right to photograph the pages. I again told Mr. Stern what my instructions were and that he needed to leave since he could not abide by those instructions. At this point, Michele walked into the entryway and asked Mr. Stern if she could help him. He asked if she was Ms. lafrate, and Michele said "yes", and reiterated that he could either a) inspect the records or b) leave. Michele showed Mr. Stern the door.
